The Bridging the Gap program and committee was put together to help newcomers getting out of treatment facilities transition into AA in their home community. As we all know, one of the most slipperiest times for a newcomer getting out of treatment is the moment they step out the door. You can help in this vital 12th step work by being a Bridging the Gap Temporary Contact volunteer to take the hand of the newcomer to a variety of meetings and introduce them to AA right here in our district. Other ways to get volunteers from your homegroup:

At 'the meeting before the meeting' and 'the meeting after the meeting', speak to as many individual members about the Bridging the Gap program that you can. Be enthusiastic about how we can be doing real 12 step work by carrying the message to the newcomer getting out of treatment! Ask for their help. Show them the volunteer form (trifold) or the www.area9btg.org website. Explain it is a short term commitment and to not expect too many calls, but if they are called it could save a life. Have them fill out the form in front of you and give it back to your Bridging the Gap Chairperson at your monthly district meeting. You can also transfer the written form information directly to the online form on the website.

Please sign up below if you are willing to give your time to those reaching out. Be a Temporary Contact for a patient getting out of treatment who is returning home to your community. Take to several local AA group meetings and introduce them to members of the fellowship and help them Bridge the Gap into Alcoholics Anonymous.

Bridging the Gap volunteers should always work in pairs. At least one of the pair should have a year's sobriety, have a sponsor, and be working the 12 Steps of Alcoholics Anonymous.
